

# CAMBODIA

## 22 - 27 January 2018

Cambodia is a Southeast Asian nation whose landscape spans low-lying plains, the Mekong Delta, mountains and Gulf of Thailand coastline. Phnom Penh, its capital, is home to the art deco Central Market, glittering Royal Palace and the National Museum's historical and archaeological exhibits. In the country's northwest are the ruins of Angkor Wat, a massive stone temple complex built during the Khmer Empire.

## DAY 1 , WELCOME TO SIEM REAP



Arrival at Siem Reap International Airport, our guide will pick you up and take you to Indian restaurant for lunch. After lunch we will start our tour by visiting lost city of the Khmer Empire. **South Gate of Angkor Thom** (was the last and most enduring capital city of the Khmer empire. It was established in the late twelfth century by King Jayavarman VII.) , **Giant faces of famous Bayon**(is a well-known and richly decorated Khmer temple at Angkor in Cambodia. Built in the late 12th or early 13th century as the official state temple of the Mahayana Buddhist King Jayavarman VII) and **Baphuon Temples**( is located in Angkor Thom, northwest of the Bayon. Built in the mid-11th century, it is a three-tiered temple mountain built as the state temple of Udayadityavarman II, dedicated to the Hindu God Shiva), **Terraces of Elephants**(is part of the walled city of Angkor Thom, a ruined temple complex in Cambodia. The terrace was used by Angkor's king Jayavarman VII as a platform from which to view his victorious returning army.) and **Leper King** (Baldwin IV (1161 – 16 March 1185), called the Leper,[1] or The Leper King reigned as King of Jerusalem from 1174 until his death. He was the son of Amalric I of Jerusalem ) till 5:30 pm.

Dinner at Indian restaurant and overnight at the hotel.

## DAY 2 , SIEM REAP



After breakfast at hotel, transfer to visit a cute pink stone of Banteay Srei temple (10TH century), regarded as the jewel in the crown of classical Khmer Art. Stop at a local village to visit families who are producing palm sugar. Continue tour to Banteay Samre, built in the 12th century. It consists of a central temple with four wings preceded by a hall and accompanied by two libraries, the southern example remarkably well preserved. Two concentric walls enclose the ensemble. Lunch will be served at Indian restaurant.

After lunch proceed to visit **Ta Prohm**, one of the area's most beautiful temples. Ta Prohm has been relatively untouched since it was discovered and retains much of its mystery. Next, visit **the Srah Srang reservoir** (known as "The Royal Baths" was once used for ritual bathing) and then visit the mountain-temple of **Pre Rup** until sunset.

## DAY 3, SIEM REAP – TONLE SAP GREAT LAKE – CITY TOURS



Enjoy morning breakfast at hotel, we will start our tours by visiting floating and fishing villages in Tonle Sap Great Lake, which one of the world's most productive bodies of fresh water. Each year, millions of fish come to spawn in the seasonally flooded forest surrounding the lake, attracting myriad water birds as well as people, who have settled in villages along the shores and who live with the rhythms of the water. After this visit Angkor National Museum which is an archaeological museum dedicated to the collection, preservation and presentation of Angkorian artifacts, also to provides information and education about art and culture of Khmer civilization, with collections mainly dated from Khmer Empire's Angkor period circa 9th to 14th-century.

Lunch will be served at Indian restaurant.

In afternoon, proceed to visit **Western Baray**, which was the water reservoir built since Angkorean era and still in used for agriculture today. Next, **War Museum** a unique collection of guns, Tanks, Jet fighters, some of these guns have even seen action during World War II. A short stop at **Wat Thmei**, it has a unique glass-walled stupa containing the bones of victims of the Khmer Rouge.

## DAY 4 , SIEM REAP – ANGKOR TEMPLE TOURS

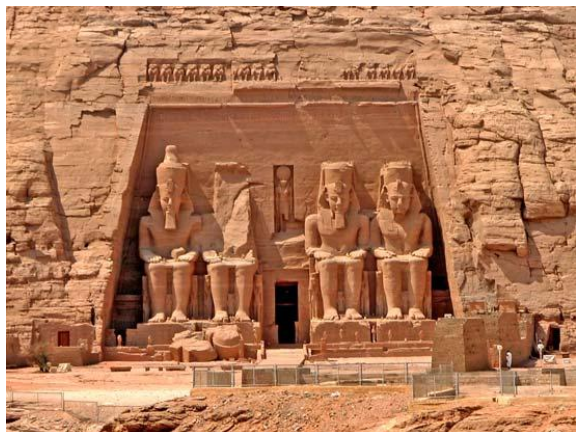


Take early morning breakfast at hotel, we will leave hotel at 7:30am to visit the most famous of all the temples on the plain of Angkor: **Angkor Wat**. The temple complex covers 81 hectares and is comparable in size to the Imperial Palace in Beijing. Its distinctive five towers are emblazoned on the Cambodian flag and the 12th century masterpiece is considered by art historians to be the prime example of classical Khmer art and architecture. Angkor Wat's five towers symbolize Meru's five peaks- the enclosed wall represents the mountains at the edge of the world and the surrounding moat, the ocean beyond.

Around 2 pm we will go to town for our lunch at Indian restaurant.
