Millennial-old monuments sit along the fertile Nile River Valley, including Giza's colossal Pyramids and Great Sphinx as well as Luxor's hieroglyph-lined Karnak Temple and Valley of the Kings tombs. The capital, Cairo, is home to Ottoman landmarks like Muhammad Ali Mosque and the Egyptian Museum, a treasure of antiquities

DAY 1 , CAIRO - ABU SIMBEL




Arrival at Cairo, the Land of Pharaohs. At international airport you will be met and assisted through immigration and customs by our representative. Board the domestic flight to Aswan. (Flight at 07:00 hrs) Reach by 08:25 hrs. Further transfer in AC vehicle to Abu Simbel. Reach by lunch time. On arrival, check in into the hotel. Time to relax. At 18:30 hrs transfer to Abu **Simbel's light & sound show**. Return to the hotel. Dinner and overnight at hotel.

DAY 2 , ABU SIMBEL TO ASWAN. LATER CRUISE




Wake up in the morning and post breakfast leave for sightseeing of Abu Simbel. The twin temples were originally carved out of the mountainside during the reign of Pharaoh Ramesses II in the 13th century BC. The complex was relocated in its entirety in 1968, on an artificial hill made from a domed structure, high above the Aswan High Dam reservoir.

Later transfer to Aswan and board the cruise. Embark on the cruise by 12:30 hrs. Later we start our tour by visiting the **High Dam**; The dam is an embankment dam built across the Nile in Aswan, Egypt between 1960 and 1970. Proceed to visit the **Unfinished Obelisk**: The unfinished obelisk is the largest known ancient obelisk and is located in the northern region of the stone quarries of ancient Egypt in Aswan. Dinner and overnight on cruise.


DAY 3 , SOBEK TEMPLE - HAROERIS IN KOMOMBO



Today sail towards Komombo at 06:30 hrs. At 08:30 hrs visit the **Temple of Sobek & Haroeris in Komombo**. The temple is unique because it is in fact a double temple, dedicated to Sobek the crocodile god, and Horus the falcon-headed god. The layout combines two temples in one with each side having its own gateways and chapels. Sail to Edfu by 10:00 hrs. Visit Edfu temple by 14:00 hrs. Later sail to Luxor.

DAY 4, VALLEY OF KINGS – THE HAPSHEPSUT TEMPLE – COLOSSI OF MEMNON



After breakfast, visit **the Valley of the Kings**, where for a period of nearly 500 years from the 16th to 11th century BC, tombs were constructed for the kings and nobles of the New Kingdom

Then proceed to visit **the Hatshepsut Temple & Colossi of Memnon** The Colossi of Memnon are two massive stone statues of the Pharaoh Amenhotep III, who reigned in Egypt during Dynasty XVIII. For the past 3,400 years (since 1350 BCE), they have stood in the Theban Necropolis, located west of the River Nile from the modern city of Luxor.

Dinner on board and stay Luxor.

DAY 5 , LUXOR TEMPLE



Breakfast on board. Disembark after breakfast. By 09:00 hrs visit to the **Luxor Temple**, it is a large Ancient Egyptian temple complex located on the east bank of the Nile River in the city today known as Luxor and was constructed approximately 1400 BCE. Also visit Karnak temple, which comprises of decayed temples, chapels, pylons and other buildings. It is the 2nd largest ancient religious site after Ankor Wat of Cambodia.

Board the train to Cairo. Overnight journey by train.

DAY 6, VISIT TO KHAN EL KHALILI BAZARS.



Enjoy morning **breakfast** on board. Reach Cairo and drive to hotel. Check in and post **Lunch at Indian Restaurant** at the Pyramids area, proceed to visit the famous **Egyptian Museum, Khan El Khalili Bazaars**; a major souk in the Islamic district of Cairo. The bazaar district is one of Cairo's main attractions for tourists and Egyptians alike. **Dinner** & overnight in the hotel.

DAY 7, ALEXANDRIA



Enjoy your **breakfast** at the hotel and then leave by A/C Coach to Alexandria (250 k.m) approx. 3 hours' drive.

We will visit **the Catacombs & Qaitbay Fort(From Outside)**.The catacombs of Kom Kom El Shoqafa is a historical archaeological site located in Alexandria, Egypt and is considered one of the Seven Wonders of the Middle Ages.

The **Citadel of Qaitbay** (or the **Fort of Qaitbay**) is a 15th-century defensive fortress located on the Mediterranean sea coast, in **Alexandria, Egypt**.

We will take our lunch **at Sea Food Restaurant** then proceed to visit the **Alexandria Library** . The Royal Library of Alexandria was one of the largest and most significant libraries of the ancient world. It was dedicated to the Muses, the nine goddesses of the arts.

Dinner and overnight in Cairo.

DAY 8, PYRAMIDS AND SPHINX



Post breakfast, by 09:00 hrs start the tour by visiting **the Pyramids & Sphinx**.

The Great Pyramid of Giza is the oldest and largest of the three pyramids in the Giza pyramid complex bordering what is now El Giza, Egypt. It is the oldest of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, and the only one to remain largely intact. The Great Sphinx lies on the east side of the complex. Current consensus among Egyptologists is that the head of the Great Sphinx is that of Khafre. Also visit **the Saqqara Pyramids**
Saqqara is a vast, ancient burial ground in Egypt, serving as the necropolis for the Ancient Egyptian capital, Memphis

Return to hotel by 13:00 hrs. Evening at leisure. Dinner and overnight at hotel.
